GENERAL BUSINESS

1. **Budget Amendment**

- a. Mayor Welden opened the public hearing on an amendment to the FY2010-2011 Budget. Jon Kies, City Clerk explained the need for the amendment. The Council discussed the sidewalk to the Veterans Memorial along Foster Boulevard.
- b. Knudson moved and Thies seconded to approve Resolution No. 2011-18 amending the current budget for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2011 with the change in the sidewalk cost to a not to exceed \$5,250 and to be a 6' wide sidewalk. Roll Vote: Knudson, Thies, Hampe and Messa voting aye.

2. Airport Runway Project

Messa moved and Knudson seconded to approve Resolution No. 2011-19 authorizing the publication of the notice of hearing and letting and the receipt of bids. Roll Vote: Messa, Knudson, Thies and Hampe voting aye.

3. **Benefit Resources of Iowa**

A presentation was given by a representative of Benefit Resources of Iowa on services. They agreed to provide services for \$10,000 per year for threes with the option for the City to withdraw at anytime.

4. Fiscal Year 2012 Budget
