

CHAPTER 77

BICYCLE REGISTRATION

77.01 REGISTRATION REQUIRED. Every person living within the City who owns a bicycle shall cause the ownership thereof to be registered at the office of the Police Department of the City or such office or location as the Police Department may designate.

77.02 IDENTIFICATION DEVICE. Upon such registration and passage of an examination designed to test the applicant's knowledge of the laws regulating the operation of bicycles in the City, and the payment of one dollar (\$1.00), the Police Department shall issue an identification device which thereafter shall be permanently attached to the bicycle in a manner and location designated by the Police Department. The registration or identification device so issued shall be valid for a period not to exceed one year from the date of issue and the identification device issued shall contain information thereon indicating the date of issuance.

77.03 SALE OR TRANSFER. In the event a registered bicycle is sold or transferred, the identification device shall pass to the new owner or transferee and the sale or transfer of the bicycle shall be reported to the Police Department by the former owner within five (5) days after the sale or the transfer of such bicycle and the Police Department shall make a record of the bicycle.

77.04 LOST IDENTIFICATION DEVICE. In the event that an owner loses the identification device or the same is destroyed or stolen, the owner shall report same immediately to the Police Department which shall then issue to such owner a new identification device at a cost of fifty cents (\$.50) to such owner.

77.05 ALTERING IDENTIFICATION DEVICE PROHIBITED. It is unlawful for any person to alter or counterfeit any identification device issued in conformity with this chapter.
